> At collection, no special handling items such as tubes, wood dowels, pillowcases, etc., will be accepted. Quilts over 90" wide/long will be gathered/pinned when hanging.

## CATEGORY DESCRIPTIONS

Please read carefully and pick only one for each entry. Write description on the front of this form.
If the category description says there are 2 sizes, it means 1) UNDER 280 inches in perimeter and 2) OVER 280 inches in perimeter. The criteria listed applies to both sizes.

1. HAND APPLIQUE: 2 sizes. At least $50 \%$ of the quilt must be hand appliquéd.
2. OTHER APPLIQUE: 2 sizes. At least $50 \%$ of the quilt must be secured by machine applique or fused or in some other manner.
3. BLOCK OF THE MONTH OR QUILTS FROM A KIT: 2 sizes. This category is for quilts where fabric was either provided or where the fabric choices were suggested so that there was little fabric or color decision made by the quilter. This category includes quilted panels and one block wonder kaleidoscopes.
4. PIECED QUILTS: 2 sizes. This may include block of the month patterns, but the fabric choice is completely determined by the quilter.
5. WHOLE CLOTH QUILTS: 2 sizes. A whole cloth quilt has no piecing. The quilting pattern is designed by the quilter. Quilted panels and medallions are NOT included in this category (See block of the month category). May include mixed media, such as inking or coloring.
6. MODERN QUILTS: 2 sizes. Modern quilts use bold solids and prints with high contrast. They may include graphic areas of solid colors, improvisational piecing, minimalism, expansive use of negative space and/or alternate grid work.
7. EMBROIDERY: 2 sizes. $50 \%$ of the quilt uses either hand embroidery or machine embroidery techniques. This would include Sue Spargo type quilts with decorative stitching.
8. ORIGINAL DESIGN: Any size. Must be an original design by the quilt maker. May be pieced or May include mixed media and embellishments.
9. ART QUILT: Any size. Commercial pattern or design, panels, pre-printed designs, may include mixed media (inks, paints, decorative stitching, embellishments).
10. ART QUILT: Any size. Literal/pictorial in style. May be either original design or commercial design/pattern. May include mixed media and embellishments.
11. ART QUILT: Any size or shape. Abstract/Improvisational, innovative. MUST be original design. May include mixed media and embellishments.
12. SUSTAINABLE QUILTS: All sizes. Uses re-purposed fabrics in at least $50 \%$ of the quilt. This category includes quilts using vintage clothing/linens, mens, women's, children's clothing, blue jeans, t-shirts, Crown Royal bags, etc.
13. WEARABLES: Includes items of fashion, such as clothing and handbags. This category does NOT include utilitarian items such as pouches/bags to hold tools and notions.
14. BEST QUILTING BY SELF: Any size. Either hand quilting or machine quilting (either hand-guided or computerized). This category judges how the appropriateness and quality of the quilting adds to the overall quality of the quilt.
15. BEST QUILTING BY OTHERS: Any size. Either hand quilting or machine quilting (either hand-guided or computerized). This category judges how the appropriateness and quality of the quilting adds to the overall quality of the quilt. We ask that you give this ribbon to the person who quilted your quilt.

SPECIAL AWARDS: Additionally, ribbons will be awarded for youth, most humorous, most unusual, most creative, president choice, president-elect's choice, viewer's choice, judges choice and best of show.
