- * Quilt Show entry fee is a \$5 suggested donation. The lite breakfast bar w/mimosa's & lunch w/wine tasting are included in entry fee.
- * All proceeds go into prize pool and are divided between guilds participating in the quilt show and contest. The amount will vary depending on number of attendees and prize ribbon contest winner level.
- * We provide all the raffle and door prizes. Proceeds from ticket sales go back into prize pool that is divided up between quilt guilds participating in quilt show contest.
- * The quilt contests are a friendly casual contest for fun with other local guilds. A minimum of 6 quilts entered to qualify and a max of 12. Local dignitaries and community members are the judges and it's a best in show contest so put out your very best to wow the judges and attendees.
- * There will be an individual quilt contest as well for those that have a quilt to enter. There is a \$3 entry fee and all proceeds go back into prize pool for the 1st – 3rd ribbon prize winners.
- * We provide the space and the quilt display setup for guilds to hang their quilts and an opportunity quilt if you have one for show.
- * Guilds may set up anytime on Friday prior to event or Saturday morning before show starts @ 9:30am.
- * Forms will be provided by Alderwood to attach to each quilt that will hang in the show for identification purposes.
- * 1 Free vendor space per guild is provided. Guilds provide their your own 6ft-8ft table.
- * Lecture and quilt history discussion by World Renowned Quilt Expert Julie Silber from 12:30-2pm.
