

Cherries

9 1/2" white on white background3 each 2 1/4' circles1/4" bias green for stems2 each green leaves

July 2018 Pieced Block

Bird Feeder

This block uses 2 1/2" strips of complimentary fabrics and a white or white-on-white fabric for the background. The block should be 10 1/2" square when finished. These directions will make 2 blocks.


Background fabric - Cut 4 each 2 1/2" X 6 1/2" rectangles

Cut 8 each 2 1/2" X 2 1/2" squares

Center complimentary fabrics (one solid and one print) -

Cut 3 each 2 1/2" X 7" rectangles of each fabric

Top/Bottom of Bird Feeder (Complimentary Print) Cut 4 each 2 1/2" X 10 1/2" rectangles



Sew 2 each 2 1/2" X 6 1/2" rectangles to opposite side of the units. Press towards the block unit.

Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner on the 2 1/2" white squares. Place the squares on each end of the 2 1/2" X 10 1/2" rectangles right side together and sew on the line. Trim to 1/4" outside the seam line and press the seam allowances toward the darker fabric. Assemble the block as shown.
