Patriotic Sun Bonnet Sue

Use a 10" piece of white or white on white background fabric.

Fabrics: Skin colored solid for hand, black for shoes, and use your imagination and give her a pretty red, white & blue dress, apron and bonnet. Give her a pretty flower or even a flag to hold.

(Winner can trim blocks to 91/2" if they wish)

Summer Flower Block

This block can be made from scraps. The large floral fabric was a 10" square. The two complementary strips were also from 10" squares. Most of the time you can find enough fabric from your stash without buying any more fabric.

Fabrics: Large bright colored floral print. (A & B)

White on White fabric (C & D)

Two different bright colored fabrics that match the floral print (F & G)

From the large floral print, cut a 7½" square and one 14" X 1½" strip.

From each of the two complementary fabrics, cut four 7½" X 1½" strips.


From the white on white fabric, cut four 2½" squares and one 14" X 1½" strip.

Using a stich and flip method, draw a diagonal line across the wrong side of the white on white $2\frac{1}{2}$ " squares (F). Sew these squares on the corners of the $7\frac{1}{2}$ " floral print (A) to make a snow-ball block. Press toward the corner and cut the back two pieces $\frac{1}{4}$ " from the sewn line.

Sew one F strip to one G strip. Repeat to make 4 strip units.

Sew the floral and white 14" X 1½" strips together. Cut apart at 1½". Make four 1½" square 4 patch units.

Sew the units together as the diagram shows to make the block. To be turned in at the July Guild Meeting.

Jack in the Box Block

Cut: White - 6 each 3 7/8" squares

Light Blue - 8 each 3 7/8" squares Royal Blue - 2 each 3 7/8" squares

Make 4 royal blue/light blue half square triangle units.


Make 12 white/light blue half square triangle units.


Make 4 units by joining one royal blue/light blue and 3 as shown.

Assemble block by joining the 4 units from step 3.

Try pressing seams open to help match points.
