

Pieced Block presented at the January 14th Meeting
(please bring completed blocks to the March 11th Meeting)

Twinkling Stars

Fabric:

Small print fabric (any color you wish)

4 rectangles each measuring 2½" x 4½"

4 squares each measuring 2½" x 2½"

White on White

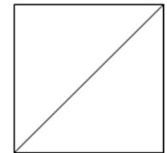
4 rectangles each measuring 2½" x 4½"

4 squares each measuring 2½" x 2½"



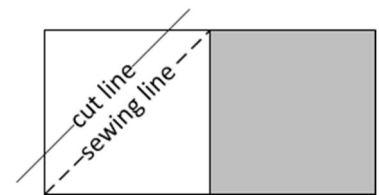
Instructions:

1. Draw a line diagonally on the back of each 2½" x 2½" square (print and white fabrics) as shown. ►



2. Place a white square on the left hand side of the print rectangle right sides together, making sure that the diagonal line goes from the bottom left corner to the top of the rectangle.

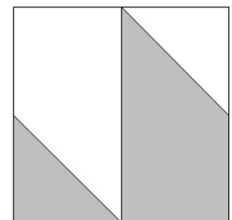
3. Sew on the marked line then trim off excess fabric ¼ from the seam then press flat as shown. ►



Repeat using the second white square and print rectangle.

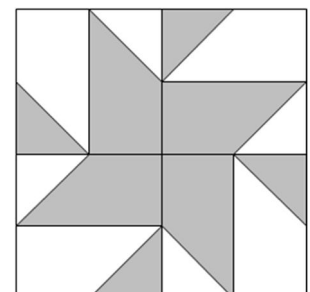
4. Repeat Steps 2 and 3, this time using the print squares and white rectangles.

5. Sew one of the print rectangle units to one of the white rectangle units with the small triangles on the outside corners as shown. ►



6. Repeat with the remaining units to create a total of 4 square units.

7. Arrange the squares as shown (with white rectangles on the outside) then sew together and press flat. ►



Note: The block should measure 8½ inches X 8½ inches (raw edge to raw edge).
