## Pieced Block presented at the March $11^{\text {th }}$ Meeting

## Cross \& Crown Block

(first made in 1900)

## Fabric:

3 Fat Quarters: 1 medium blue batik, 1 solid purple, and 1 lavender.

## Cutting Instructions:

1. Medium blue batik: Cut 2 squares $47 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times 47 / 8^{\prime \prime}, 4$ squares $27 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times 27 / 8^{\prime \prime}$, 4 squares $2 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 2 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime}$, and 4 rectangles $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 4 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime}$
2. Purple: Cut 2 squares $47 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times 47 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ and 4 squares $27 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times 27 / 8^{\prime \prime}$
3. Lavender: Cut 2 rectangles $2^{\prime \prime} \times 61 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ and 1 rectangle $2 \prime \times 14^{\prime \prime}$

## Piecing Instructions:



1. Draw a line diagonally on the wrong side of each blue $47 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ square and each $27 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ square.
2. Lay a blue $47 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ square face up on your work surface and place a matching purple square face down on top of it (i.e. right sides together) then sew a scant $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ on each side of the drawn line as shown.
3. Cut apart along the drawn line then open and press seams towards the blue fabric. Trim each half-square triangle unit to $41 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$.
** Repeat Steps 2-3 using the remaining marked blue squares and matching purple squares to make a total of 4 blue-purple $41 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares. Then repeat Steps $2-3$ using the marked $27 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ blue squares and the $27 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ purple squares, trimming them to $2 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 2 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime}$ to make a total of 8 blue-purple $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ units.
4. Sew 4 blue $2 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares to 4 blue-purple $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 2 \frac{1}{2 \prime}$ units being very careful to orient the half-square triangle unit exactly as shown.

5. Sew 4 blue $2 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 2 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime}$ squares to the remaining blue-purple $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 2 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime}$ units being careful to orient the half-square triangle unit exactly as shown.
6. Create a Crown Unit by joining a Step 4 unit, a Step 5 unit, and blue-purple
$41 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ half-square triangle unit, being very careful to orient each of the units exactly as shown.
**Repeat to make a total of 4 crown units.
7. Join a Crown Unit to each long side of a $2^{\prime \prime} \times 61_{2}^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle then sew each of those units to the long side of the $2^{\prime \prime} \times 14^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle, being very careful to orient each unit exactly as shown in the photo at the top of the page so that the tips point outwards towards the block corners.


Note: Your block should measure exactly 14 " x 14 ".
