## "Sending Flowers" Appliqué Block

## Presented at the July $15^{\text {th }}$ meeting

(Bring completed blocks to the September $9^{\text {th }}$ meeting)

1. For the background cut a $101 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ square of pastel fabric (e.g. pink, yellow, pale green or blue). Note: If doing needle turn, cut an $11^{\prime \prime}$ square and trim to $101 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ after completing the appliqué.
2. The sides, bottom and flap of the envelope should be sewn using white fabric.

Note: you can use solids or tone-on-tone fabrics.
3. For the flowers you can fussy cut flowers from floral fabric, appliqué using regular fabrics, or even embroider the flowers. Can also use a fabric pen for stems. Personalize any way you'd like. Below are a few examples:
