## Ribbon Star Variation

## Fabrics (all should be solids, tone-on-tone, or marbled):

White:
4 squares that each measure $2^{\prime \prime} \times 2^{\prime \prime}$ 8 rectangles that each measure $2^{\prime \prime} \times 3^{\prime \prime}$ 4 rectangles that each measure $2^{\prime \prime} \times 41 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ 4 squares that each measure $41 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 41 /{ }^{\prime \prime}$
Light blue:
4 squares that each measure $2^{\prime \prime} \times 2^{\prime \prime}$
8 rectangles that each measure $2^{\prime \prime} \times 31 / 4 "$
Dark blue:
1 square that measures $2^{\prime \prime} \times 2^{\prime \prime}$


## Instructions:



1. Construct the center 9 -patch unit using the $2^{\prime \prime} \times 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares. Sew 2 rows with white/light-blue/white and 1 row of light-blue/dark-blue/light-blue as shown. Press seams towards the light-blue fabric in all 3 rows. Sew the rows together with the dark-blue square in the center then press the seams.
2. Lay the white $2^{\prime \prime} \times 3^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles face down on your work surface then draw a diagonal line at a 45 degree angle on the back of 4 of them from lower right to upper left and on the back of the other 4 from upper left to lower right.

3. Place the blue 2 " $\times 3 \frac{1}{4}$ " rectangles face up on your work surface then, using the diagram at the right as a guide, place a white rectangle face down on top of each at a right angle as shown
Sew along the marked lines then trim off the corners and press seams towards the blue fabric.


Note: The component should measure exactly 2" x 41/4".
4. Using the diagram on the right as a guide, sew a side unit using a pair of left and right angled components from Step 3 plus a white 2 " $\times 41 / 4$ " rectangle. Press seams towards the light blue fabric.
Repeat to form a total of 4 side units.

5. Complete the block using the Center 9-Patch, the 4 Side Units, and the 4 white $41 / 4$ " $41 / 4 \prime$ squares by sewing them into 3 rows as shown
6. Press seam towards the side units in each row then sew the 3 rows together and press the seams.

Note: Your block should measure exactly 121/4" x 121/4".
