Rosebud Block

Fabric Requirements and Cutting:

White on White fabric:

Cut 4 squares 2\%" x 2\%"

Cut 2 more squares 2\%" x 2\%" then crosscut them once diagonally

Cut 2 squares 6%" x 6%" then crosscut them once diagonally

Marbled Red or Pink fabric:


Cut 4 squares 2%" x 2%"

Cut 2 squares 4%" x 4%" then crosscut both of them once diagonally



Piecing Instructions:

- 1. Draw a diagonal line (corner to corner) on the wrong side of each White 2½" x 2½" square (this line will later be used as a cutting line). Mark a scant ½" seam line on each side of the cutting line as shown. ▶
- 2. Lay the 4 Red/Pink 2½" x 2½" squares face up on your work surface and position a marked White 2½" x 2½" square face down on top of each; Sew along the marked lines then cut apart along the cutting line, press seams towards the dark fabric, and trim to 2½" x 2½". ▶
- 3. Join two Step 2 units to a White 2%" triangle then press towards the dark fabric to form a unit as shown. ▶
 - **Repeat Step 3 to create 4 of these units.
- 4. Using the diagram at the right as a guide, sew a Red/Pink 4%" triangle to each of the Step 3 units.
- 5. Using the diagram at the right as a guide again, sew a White 6½" triangle to each of the units from Step 4.



Note: Your completed block should measure exactly 12½" x 12½" (raw edge to raw edge).
