## Rosebud Block

## Fabric Requirements and Cutting:

White on White fabric:
Cut 4 squares $27 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times 27 / 8^{\prime \prime}$
Cut 2 more squares $27 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times 27 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ then crosscut them once diagonally Cut 2 squares $67 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times 67 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ then crosscut them once diagonally

Marbled Red or Pink fabric:
Cut 4 squares 27/8" x $27 / 8^{\prime \prime}$


Cut 2 squares $47 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times 47 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ then crosscut both of them once diagonally

## Piecing Instructions:

1. Draw a diagonal line (corner to corner) on the wrong side of each White $27 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times 27 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ square (this line will later be used as a cutting line). Mark a scant $1 / 4$ " seam line on each side of the cutting line as shown.

2. Lay the 4 Red/Pink $27 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times 27 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ squares face up on your work surface and position a marked White $27 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times 27 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ square face down on top of each; Sew along the marked lines then cut apart along the cutting line, press seams towards the dark fabric, and trim to $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$.
3. Join two Step 2 units to a White $27 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ triangle then press towards the dark fabric to form a unit as shown.
**Repeat Step 3 to create 4 of these units.

4. Using the diagram at the right as a guide, sew a Red/Pink 47/8" triangle to each of the Step 3 units.
5. Using the diagram at the right as a guide again, sew a White $67 /{ }^{\prime \prime}$ triangle to each of the units from Step 4.
6. Sew the 4 rosebud units from Step 5 together as shown on the right.

Note: Your completed block should measure exactly $121 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 121 / 2$ " (raw edge to raw edge).
