Antique Tile Block


Fabric Requirements and Cutting:

Light – Cut 1 square 2½" x 2½" and 1 strip 1½" x 11" Medium – Cut 1 strip 1½" x 7" and 1 strip 1½" x 11" Dark – Cut 1 strip 1½" x 7" and 4 rectangles 1½" x 2½"




Piecing Instructions:

- 1. Join the Light 1½" x 11" strip and the Medium 1½" x 11" strip by sewing along the long edges; press seam towards the Light fabric. The strip should measure 2½" across.
- 2. Trim 1/8"-1/4" from one end of the strip then crosscut 4 sections that are 21/2" each as shown below to form the Side Units.



- 3. Join the Medium $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x 7" strip and the Dark $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x 7" strip by sewing along the long edges; press seam towards the Dark fabric. The strip should measure $2\frac{1}{2}$ " across.
- 4. Trim \%"-\%" from one end of the strip then crosscut 4 sections that are 1\%" each as shown below.



5. Sew a Dark 1½" x 2½" rectangle to the side of each Step 4 unit as shown ► Press seams towards the Dark fabric. These are the Corner Units.



- 6. Using the diagram at the right as a guide, arrange the Light 2½" x 2½" square, the Side Units created in Step 2 and Corner Units created in Step 5 into 3 rows. ▶
- 7. Press the seams towards the corner units in Rows 1 and 3 and towards the center in Row 2.
- 8. Sew the rows together and press the seams.

Note: Your assembled block should now measure exactly 6½" x 6½".
