Pieced Block presented at the January 11th Meeting

(please bring completed blocks to the March 8th Meeting)

A Study in Contrasts Block

Notes:

- This block uses 4 colors within a color scheme a dark and light of the same main color, a contrasting color (i.e. directly opposite the main color on a color wheel), plus a white-on-white for the background.
- The sizes given in parentheses below can be used if you prefer to trim your half-square triangle (HST) units rather than worrying about sewing an accurate scant ¼" seam allowance.

Fabric Requirements and Cutting:

Background – Cut: 2 squares 4%" x 4%" (5" x 5") and 4 rectangles 2%" x 4%" Dark Main – Cut 1 square 4%" x 4%" and 8 squares 2%" x 2%" Light Main – Cut 2 squares 4%" x 4%" (5" x 5") Contrasting Color – Cut 4 rectangles 2%" x 4%"

Piecing Instructions:

- Draw a diagonal line (corner to corner) on the wrong side of the White 4⁷/₈" x 4⁷/₈" (5" x 5") squares. This line will later be used as a cutting line. Mark a *scant* ¹/₄" seam line on each side of the cutting line as shown. ►
- 2. Lay the Light 4⁷/₈" x 4⁷/₈" (5" x 5") squares face up on your work surface and position the marked White 4⁷/₈" x 4⁷/₈" (5" x 5") right side down on top (right sides together).
- 3. Sew along the marked ¼" seam lines then cut apart along the marked cutting line; press seams towards the Light fabric to form 2 Half-Square Triangle (HST) units as shown. ►

Note: If you were using 5" x 5" squares, trim each HST unit to exactly 4½" x 4½".

- 4. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the 8 Dark Main 2½" x 2½" and place one right side down on the left side of each White 2½" x 4½" rectangle. ►
- 5. Sew on the marked line then cut away the excess from the corner and press seam towards the Dark fabric.
- 6. Lay the remaining Dark 2½" x 2½" marked squares right side down on the other side of the Step 4 units as shown. ►
- 7. Sew on the marked line then cut away the excess from the corner and press seams towards the Dark fabric to create 4 Flying Geese Units then sew a Contrasting 2½" x 4½" rectangle to each Flying Geese unit as shown. ►
 Press to contrasting fabric.
- 8. Arrange the Step 2 to HST units and the Flying Geese units into 3 rows as shown below right then sew the units in each row together. Press top and bottom rows outward and middle row seams inward.
- 9. Sew the rows together to complete the block. Note: Your assembled block should now measure exactly 12½" x 12½". Do not trim your block! Thank You!
