## Children's Delight Pieced Block (from the late 1800's)

## **Fabric Requirements and Cutting:**

Focus fabric (playful or summery colors) Cut:

4 squares 2½" x 2½"

2 rectangles 2½" x 8½"

1 square 4½" x 4½".

Light fabric (cream, tan, etc.) Cut:

1 square 2½" x 2½"

4 rectangles 2½" x 4½"



## **Piecing Instructions:**

Sew a 2½" x 2½" Focus fabric square to each end of 2 of the Light fabric 2½" x 4½" rectangles as shown. ►
 Press seams towards Focus fabric.



2. Sew a 2½" x 4½" Light fabric rectangle to opposite sides of the Focus fabric 4½" x 4½" square as shown ►

Press seams towards Focus fabric.




3. Sew the 2½" x 2½" Light fabric square to one end of the Focus fabric 2½" x 8½" rectangles as shown. ►

Press seams towards Focus fabric.



- 4. Using the graphic on the right as a guide, arrange the block units then:
  - a. Join Rows 1, 2 and 3 together as shown; press seams towards row 2 (i.e. the middle row).
  - b. Sew the remaining Focus fabric 2½" x 8½" rectangle to the side of the unit created in Step 4a; press seam towards the Side piece just added.
  - c. Sew Step 3 unit to the bottom of the unit created in Step 4b; press seams towards the Bottom unit just added.



Your assembled block should measure exactly 10½" x 10½". Do not trim your block! Thank You!
