

Zen Garden Class Supplies

What you'll need for this class:

Fabric: Prior to the introductory session, review the pattern and select the required fabric.

If you've done a Judy Niemeyer class before, cut out your papers (Units with a ~1/4 extra and temples on the line). Be sure you **DO NOT** cut apart templates that are joined together. They will be cut apart with a stack of fabric under them.

If you need help with fabric quantities, the kitting sheet may help. A downloadable PDF version of the sheet is available on the class event posting page (<http://msquilters.com/event/carol-hattan-zen-garden-class/>). As you'll see, it is made with a Quiltworx Strip set. This is the easiest way to get the look. It is possible to do the quilt with (48) 2.5 inch strips. In a Quiltworx strip set these are presorted into 6 sets of color with 8 strips per set.

Pattern: Zen Garden, finished size is 80" x 80". The pattern includes instructions, cover sheet, yardage information, and foundation papers.

Supplies:

- Sewing Machine, power cord, foot peddle, ¼ - inch foot or ability to adjust to a 1/4-inch,
- New needle: (recommend size 70 microtex (sharp) or 80 microtex (sharp)).
- Thread to blend with our fabrics
- Rotary cutter, small mat, and ruler. (Make sure you have a good blade)
- Seam ripper
- Flower Head pins
- Scissors small
- Glue stick (water soluble) and glue pen and repositionable glue (I will have some of these with me.)
- Scotch tape
- Plastic bag and paper clips
- If you have a Purple "Thang" or stiletto, bring it along.
- Add a quarter 6 or 12
- You also need a folding temple when you work. I will have this for you.
