

Mountain Stars Quilters Guild  
Meeting - 12/10/83

The minutes from the previous meeting were approved as read.

Discussion as to whether name tags should be worn at meetings. Members were requested to come up with ideas.

The Treasurer's report was read: balance: \$546.88.

Joyce Coulter reported on what Katie Pasquini can provide. It was moved and seconded to ask Ms. Pasquini to give a morning workshop (25 people), a mid-day lecture, and an afternoon workshop (25 people). The morning workshop would be cancelled if there were not enough people. The lecture would be "Painting With Cloth"; the workshop is "Color Theory". The lecture fee is \$150; workshop fee is \$250. Travel, room and board are extra. Admittance fees were not decided on.

Joyce also announced that Suzy Lawson will lecture on Amish quilts - half hour for \$150. Mary Cross will lecture on Grant Wood Retrospective for \$100. She will also date quilts for \$5 each.

There was discussion on where to have the workshops that require sewing machines. Judy Pierce suggested a school home economics classroom would be a good place and she will check with the Talent and Phoenix schools. Jenny Williams will check in Medford.

There was discussion about the use of the U.S. Hotel Ballroom in Jacksonville could be used for the Katie Pasquini lecture, and if so, what the fee would be.

The new logo for the guild was voted on, the design by Dora Scheidecker. A motion was made and passed that a banner be made with the guild paying for the materials. Claudia Ross-Kelley and Margaret Hunsaker volunteered to make the banner if Dora furnished the fabric and pattern.

There was discussion as to whether the newsletter should be sent out right after the meetings with a postcard reminder before the next meeting. It was decided this would be too expensive. Current distribution decided to be satisfactory.

Lynda Thirlwall asked members to contribute any information, inspiration, and/or quilt and fabric shop names to her for the newsletter. Gwen Paden offered the information that one ounce white iodine to one quart water will set fabric dyes.
