

MOUNTAIN STARS GENERAL MEETING

September 8, 1984

Dorothy Herberg gave a report on the symposium held in Oakland, Calif. in July and attended by her, Wanda McDermitt, and Gerry Lewis. The membership list is being prepared. There was discussion of interest-bearing checking accounts.

It was decided that at this time the club does not have enough in the treasury to consider an account such as that.

It was announced that the Hugo Ladies' Club Quilt Show will be held October 6.

The December meeting will be held the eighth in Ashland, at Andre's Restaurant. Those interested will have lunch before the meeting. Details will go into the Newsletter.

The program was a round table discussion by representatives of the Hugo, Klamath Falls, Rogue River, and Jacksonville groups, outlining goals, etc. of groups. A question and answer period followed. The meeting was adjourned at 3 p.m.
