

The meeting was called to order by President Dorothy Herberg. The minutes of the 12/86 meeting were approved as printed in the March Newsletter.

Treasurer's Report: Phyllis Bonnville reported the balance on hand 12/6/86 was \$1128.31. With receipts and disbursements, the balance on hand as of 3/14/87 is \$1095.81.

Introductions: Guests were introduced and new member, Carmen Hernandez, with Piecemakers was welcomed to the guild. Guild Quilt Show: Anita Ledwidge reported that the Women's Club, Grants Pass, has been selected as the site for the show May 16, "Quilt Connection." Entries for the show are needed by May 1. There will be voting for popular choice. There was discussion of which of 2 lecture topics we want Mary Cross to present - Afro-American Quilts or DAR Quilts. DAR Quilts was selected. Mary Cross will also be available to do some documentation of quilts. Anita's husband can make plastic racks-frames for quilt displays @ \$20 each. Motion for the Guild to purchase 10 frames passed.

Members voted to have a donation box next to the sign-up sheet at the show. Flyers giving details of the show will be sent to the membership. Sign up sheets for goodies, quilt works, and door prizes were circulated at the meeting.

Sisters Trip: This trip is scheduled for July 10-11. Cost will be \$45 per person double occupancy, \$55 single occupancy. Full payment is required 3 weeks in advance (June 19). The maximum number for the trip is 40. A sign up sheet was circulated and more information will be sent to the membership.

Election of Officers: The nominating committee recommended Jay Ritter for vice president and Vicky Newhouse for secretary. There were no nominations from the floor. The slate was accepted by unanimous vote.

Moonlighters: Phyllis Bonville and Gerry Lewis have agreed to lead this group's activities.

Announcements: Dorothy Herberg has been accepted to participate in the "Shining Stars" show at the annual Houston quilt show in the fall.

Donna Goodland of Yreka announced they are having a show 4/25-26. She displayed a lovely quilt- a variation of grandmother's flower garden - to be raffled at the show.
