Minutes of the Meeting of June 10, 1989

The regular Guild meeting was called to order by the president, Dora Scheidecker. The minutes were approved as mailed and the Treasurer's balance was \$1943.17.

Hachel Razzolini conducted a brief installation of new officers. Retiring Vice-president Jay Ritter and Secretary Vicki Newhouse were given certificates of thanks. New officers Elinor Jones and Elaine Turcke assumed their duties.

Anita Ledwidge reported on the recent Quilt Show. Thanks were extended to all helpers. It was generally agreed that having craft tables is worthwhile. It was decided that left over craft items be sold by silent auction at the close of this meeting.

Dora presented a proposed policy concerning the selling of raffle tickets at Mountain Stars Shows as it appeared in the June Newsletter page 3 col.1. After discussion it was moved by Joyce Coulter, seconded by Susanne Parker and passed by those present to accept the Board recommendation. Susanne will check on the legal ramifications of selling raffle tickets.
NOTE: This years raffle quilt was won by Denver Hardin.

Susanne Parker is chairman of the 1990 Mountain Stars Show to be held at the Jacksonville Ballroom on May 12. Format will be auction, quilt show and fashion show. Honorees will be Joyce Coulter, Dorothy Herberg and Diane Kelley. There will be a separate treasurer for the event next year. Plans include finishing of the Christmas quilt for this show.

Members were encouraged to complete the questionnaire regarding Moonlighters. Decisions will be made in the next few months as to the format for the group. Gerry Lewis was thanked for her leadership of the Moonlighters over the past two years. Leftover supplies and kits were distributed to members for storage over the summer.

The Board recommendation regarding rental for our quilt racks was presented. Discussion centered around previous policy and whether we need more racks. It was voted to charge \$5 for a one day show and \$20 for a week. The Board will consider this item again at its next meeting.

Joy Nichols presented a very interesting program on Baltimore applique and showed some outstanding samples.
