The formal business meeting was adjourned and members presented show and tell. Many interesting items were shown. Pat Hatfield alerted members to an article in QNM Nov/Dec '87 on an easy way to make miniature quilts and showed some samples of the method.

The speaker, Betsy Lanning, presented a program on applique using freezer paper templates. Those present were able to make a small sample using this technic. Refreshments were served by the Jacksonville Women Quilters. Next guild meeting is June 9.
