General Meeting  
Hugo Ladies Club June 15, 1991

The June meeting was called to order by President Rachel Razzolini at 1:00 PM. The minutes were approved. Treasurer's report was read by Judy Kaplan, with balance on hand of \$2,492.13

Two guests were introduced and encouraged to return.

OLD BUSINESS: Grace Anderson has rescheduled her workshop "Fabric Landscape Tapestry" to July 19, or in August. The class is from 9:00 to 1:00 PM, with a cost of \$35.00.

Members modeled; giving an up close and personal view of a "classy jean look" to an elegant sparkle and lace sweatshirt for an evening out. These jackets were through classes by Grace Anderson. Rowena modeled a vest she made in a class with Marian Leaman---Creative Hands. Theresa Robinson of Calico Junction was not available to show their work.

Patriotic Squares: There was a group discussion about the red, white and blue blocks. Anita prompted this project and wished a wall quilt to be made to present at patriotic and other occasions on behalf of Mt. Stars, as a memory of "Desert Storm". A motion was made and seconded to select a committee to plan the quilt setting to be presented at the September meeting and in the 1992 Mt. Stars Show. Also, the committee would present a design and fabric choices for a raffle quilt in 1993. Challenge packet fabric will be considered.
