Rowena Kerber showed her latest quilt in the Round Robin Quilt Challenge sponsored by That Patchwork Place University. Jennie Williams displayed her Cherry Basket quilt which was pieced in 1965 with the cherry fabric found in 1991. Mother-Daughter team Nancy Graden and Liane John showed several examples of Carolyn Pimental's Flip & Sew Fan blocks in regular to miniature sizes. Examples of Liane's work can be seen in the Spring 1994 issue of MINIATURE QUILTS. Monika Jones displayed her Feathered Star from a Louise Kindig class. Gerry Lewis shared her completely hand done 8-Pointed Star done with a border print with each block looking entirely different. Pat Hatfield and Joyce Coulter brought the Pottsville Raffle Quilt named American Irish Chain which will be drawn for on Father's Day. Youngest participant was Katryn Little showing her first quilt a Heart and 9 Patch.
