

# Minutes of March 1999 Meeting

President *Susanne Enos* convened the meeting at 12:40 PM announcing we would be having our speaker first so she could catch her plane. Susanne introduced *Charlotte Warr Andersen* whose topic was "*Buying fabrics that have the look you need*". By means of slides she showed how she chooses fabrics that emulate particular images she needs ie flowers, rocks, water, sky, trees, etc. Charlotte showed slides of quilts (many of her own), then the slide of the particular fabric she used to make the image portrayed in her quilt. Charlotte ended by showing several of her original award winning quilts.

The business meeting followed at 2:20 PM. After guests and new members were introduced the December 1998 minutes were approved as printed in the newsletter. Treasurer, *Chris Dutcher*, gave the current report with the February 28, 1999, balance as being \$4,581.39. A motion to amend the bylaws as set forth in the December 1998 newsletter was made, seconded and passed. Accordingly, Article II, section 3d of the bylaws now reads, "*The treasurer shall be responsible for the guild membership list*". President Susanne presented the slate of officers to be elected for terms starting June 1999. By unanimous vote *Sue Roberts* will serve as President-elect, *Kathy Butts* as Vice President and *Julie Waller* as Secretary. *Rosie Jenkins* was appointed as block-of-the-season chair. *Laura Ives* continues as hospitality chair, however, providing refreshments will go back to the old method of having individual groups be responsible. President Susanne announced that new Mountain Stars pins have been ordered and hopefully will be here in time for the April quilt show. Pins will be available to members for \$3, non-members \$5. Susanne also made known *Harriet Hargrave* is scheduled to be our featured teacher and speaker next spring. Members are

urged to let *Sharon Little* know if they have a favorite quilt teacher they would like to see come to Mountain Stars in the future.

*Joann Stuebing* announced a "garage sale" for the June meeting. Members are urged to clean out their sewing rooms, bring quilt related items to the June meeting and donate proceeds to Mountain Stars. The sale is to begin when the first items arrive and will continue all day. If you see something you can use, take it and donate the price it is worth to you! The Opportunity Quilt for 2001, which Jo constructed and donated, needs to be quilted. Anyone who can is urged to take it, quilt a bit, then pass it on. Jo needs someone to be in charge of the quilt. The 1999 Opportunity Quilt has taken in just over \$1800. The drawing will take place at our quilt show, April 18. Jo also announced the Diamond Lake Mystery Retreat features a *Judy Hopkins* pattern. Sign-up needs to be prior to August.



A sign-up sheet for those wishing to participate in the annual fabric exchange was passed with members being urged to bring any '30s quilts they may have to show and tell in June. A sign-up sheet for those members who wish to have their e-mail addresses listed was also passed. The block-of-the-season "Hearts on a Vest" was won by *Susanne Enos*. *Dolores Vietti* gave a quilt show update. The meeting ended with show and tell and dismissed at 3:45 PM.
