Color 1 - Batiks. Color 2 - Creams  
 For a Springy look!!  
 It's a 12-1/2" block unfinished.  
 Thank You for not trimming!!  
 All seams a scant 1/4".  
 HST = Half Square Triangle

## \*\* Supplies List \*\*



Color 1 Color 1 needs: One 7" square AND 3-1/2" x 7" strip AND one 4" x 8" strip.

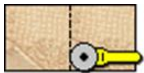


Color 2 Color 2 needs: One 7" square AND one 3-1/2" x 7" strip AND 4" x 8" strip.

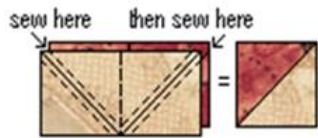
## \*\* Preparing the Pieces and Sewing the Block \*\*



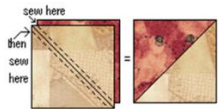
First cut Color 1 3-1/2" x 7" strip into two 3-1/2" squares.



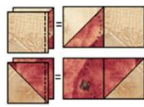
Then cut Color 2 3-1/2" x 7" strip into two 3-1/2" squares.



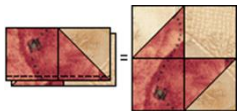
Now speed piece the small HST by stacking the Color 1 and Color 2 4" x 8" strips right sides together. On the back of the top strip lightly mark the 4" square line and the diagonals. Then mark a line 1/4" on each side of the diagonal. These are sew lines. Sew on these lines, pivoting at the square line. Cut apart ON the center diagonal lines and on the square line. This will give you 4 HST. Press seams to the dark side. Square up to 3-1/2".



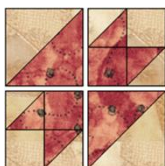
Repeat this procedure with the large (7") Color 1 and Color 2 squares to make large HST. Press seam to dark side. Square to 6-1/2".



Sew the corner units by sewing a Color 2 3-1/2" square to a HST unit on the right edge. Sew another HST unit to a Color 1 square. Make 2 of each of these units. Press seam towards square. (Unit measures 6-1/2" x 3-1/2")



Sew the 1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> units (just made) together along the bottom edge. Press seam allowance towards the bottom unit. Make 2 of these units. (Unit measures 6-1/2" x 6-1/2")



Piece the block. Sew each of the 2 large HST squares to a corner unit. Alternate pressing directions. And you're done!! (I pressed final seam open.)
